

Multiplication Practice 1

You can multiply by doing **repeated addition**. For example,

$$3 \times 4 = 3 + 3 + 3 + 3 \text{ OR } 4 + 4 + 4$$

Either way the answer comes out the same, 12. However, it is quicker to add the greater number.

Directions: Solve the following multiplication equations by doing repeated addition of the greater number.

1) $5 \times 3 =$ 5 is the greater number, so add 5 three times. $5 + 5 + 5 = 15$ The product is <u>15</u> .	2) $2 \times 6 =$ The product is _____.
